

Chrome – Block Notifications

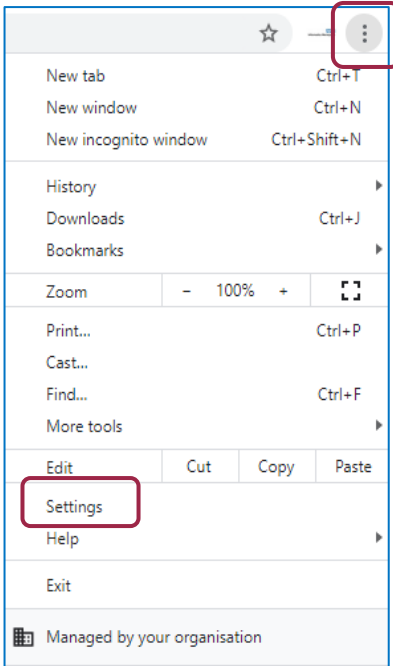
Within the search engine Chrome, it is possible to block notifications from specific websites. This can be useful when consulting with AttendAnywhere, as it will prevent visual notifications appearing when patients are in the waiting room.

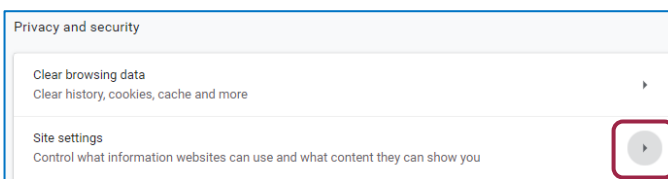
- On your computer, [open Chrome](#)



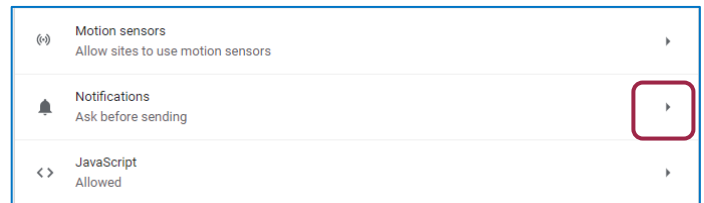
- Open the [Customise menu](#) in the top right hand corner → select [Settings](#).



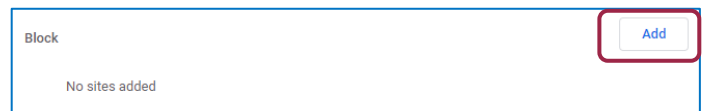
- From [Privacy and security](#), open [Site settings](#).



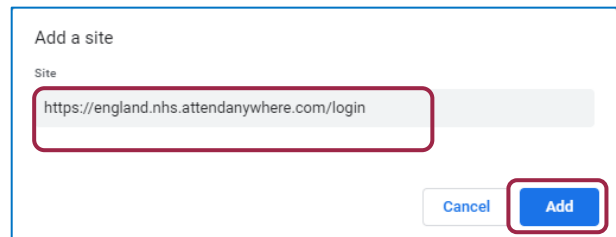
- From [Site settings](#), open [Notifications](#).



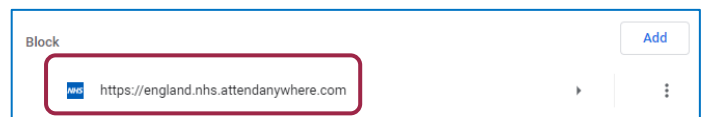
- Click [Add](#) from the [Block](#) section.
